Licking County Job and Family Services is offering limited COVID-19 Emergency Services for Licking County residents impacted by COVID-19 virus.

Licking County Job and Family Services is offering emergency assistance for families impacted by the COVID-19 virus. Families who have experienced unexpected expenses and/or job loss or due to the COVID-19 virus may apply. You may be eligible if you are a family with minor children in the household, AND meet income guidelines listed below.

Services covered under this program include:

Services provided must address an emergency need caused by COVID-19 crisis such as unexpected household expenses and other ongoing expenses.

Priority would be given to expenses related to preparing for or involvement in self-quarantine and social distancing. Other services considered may include: rent/housing and deposits, Mortgage Assistance, Utilities, Car Payments/Car Insurance. JFS Case Managers will work with each caller/applicant to determine which assistance may be the most appropriate.

Disaster assistance will not be provided for a service provided/covered by another agency program or insurance benefit. Services provided must be related to loss caused by COVID-19 including but not limited to the inability to work due to issues caused by the COVID-19 virus.

Applicants will be required to complete an application, and provide Job and Family Services records necessary to process the request for COVID-19 Services which includes receipts/documentation of eligible expenses, Income verification.
